

We start Certificate Issuance Service at convenience stores from April 2024. It becomes possible to obtain certificates at convenience stores using My Number Card (Indivisual Number Card) (without filling in a paper application form).

250 yen

*When you obtain the certificates at Onojo City Hall and each community center using Citizen Card (Shimin Card), the fee is 300 yen the same as before.

Safety of Procedure

You can obtain the certificates with safety as you can obtain the certificates operating a multi-copy machine installed at a convenience store etc. by yourself without being seen by anybody.

●My Number Card can be used for...

- ♦ Verifying identity
- ♦ Health Insurance Card (can be used only at medical institutions installing a My Number Card reader.)
- ♦Filing a final tax return through e-Tax (online).
- ♦One-stop special application of Hometown Tax Donation, Furusto Nozei
- ♦ Obtaining the certificates such as residence certificate, certificate of seal registration and taxation certificate, etc. through **City Online Application**.

A My Number Card is a plastic card which contains an IC chip, and the bearer's name, address, My Number (the Individual Number), and ID photograph, etc., are displayed on it. This card can be used to verify identify on line safely and surely, therefore, it will be a necessary item in a digital society.

- ◆Place garbage in a designated area until 10 o'clock at night
- ◆Tie up the top of a city-designated waste disposal bag firmly
- ◆Sort garbage correctly
- ◆Check garbage collection days in the area you live
- ●Glass bottles and Cans 2nd and 4th designated days of the month
- ●Other non-burnable garbage 3rd designated day of the month
- Pet bottles (Plastic bottles) and White Plastic Trays 1st and 3rd designated days of the month

Payment of school lunch fees

Under School Lunches Act, school lunch is provided only with the cost of ingredients. School lunch fee at elementary school and junior high school is revised due to the rise of prices this year. Financial support for school lunch fee will be provided this year as the same as last year for the rise of prices. The payment by guardians will be the amount that 1,096 yen (equivalent to cost of milk) is deducted from monthly school lunch fee.

- School lunch fees (monthly fee) (April 2024 March 2025)
 - ♦ Elementary school 5,480 yen (Last year: 5,100 yen)
 - ◆Payment by guardians: 4,384 yen (after financial support is applied.)
 - ♦ Junior high school 1,096 yen (for milk) (last year: 951 yen)
 - ◆Payment by guardians: 0 yen, free (after financial support is applied.)

*Fee of School Lunch Service for junior high school is the same as last year and is 250 yen per meal.

Application for using "Randoseru-Club", After-school Day Care, (R-registration) of Academic Year 2024

City provides "Randoseru-Club" to take care of children after school. There are 2 registration types, G-registration and R-registration. City starts to accept application for R-registration of "Randoseru-Club".

R-registration

- Choose 3 days from school days.
- After hours care is not available.
- Not available during school holidays (spring, summer and winter holidays, compensatory days off, Saturdays).
- *You might use 2 types together for spring, summer and winter holidays or Saturdays if you fulfill the conditions we require. For further information, please contact us.
- No requirements
- *Days you can choose differ from school to school.
- *The number of students we can accept is limited.
- Subject School All elementary schools in Onojo City
- **Subject Person** Elementary school 1st 6th grade students
- Day Care Period from June 2024 to February 2025
 - *Except school days without school lunch, Holidays, Saturdays and Sundays
- *You use the day care though Academic Year 2024.
- Day Care Cost (A fee exemption is available) 1,500 yen per month
 - *There is no fee on a daily basis.
- Day Care Time After-school 5:00pm
- Application Period Fri, Apr. 12th Mon, Apr. 22nd
