If you fail to submit the said notification documents by the deadline, you might not receive your allowance continuously. Please make sure to submit the notification documents at Childrearing Support Section by the deadline.

## Please take the procedure for renewal of Single-Parent Family Medical Certificate and Persons with Severe Disabilities Medical Certificate in August

### ○Single-Parent Family Medical Certificate

The Notification has been sent to a subject person at the end of July. If you fall behind in the procedure, you will not be entitled to receive the said medical certificate and aid of October and later months.

### ○Persons with Severe Disabilities Medical Certificate

As to "Persons with Severe Disabilities Medical Certificate", it will be renewed automatically. We will send the notification letter individually by postal mail to those who need to submit documents.

## Revision of Day-care Fee and Reduction or Exemption of Side Dish Fee of Authorized Nursery Schools in Onojo City

Based on "municipal tax in FY2023", the day-care fee is revised and the side dish fee is reduced or exempted from September. We will contact subject households who need to take the procedure for this.

### ○Day-care Fee

The day-care fee is decided based on the total amount of municipal taxes in FY2023 (per-income levy) of subject child's parents and the age of the subject child as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. For further details, please contact us.

(for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> doses)

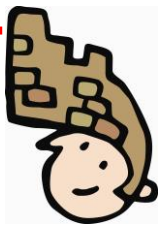
