Vaccination Fee

Free (until Mar. 31st, 2024) *Fee will be charged from April 1st, 2024. *In the case that you receive treatment, you need to pay the fee which is covered by insurance.

■Vaccination Interval

3 or more months after the previous COVID-19 vaccination

Vaccine Type

Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine targeting Omicron subvariant XBB.1.5
