

Emergency Support Benefit for Rise of Price of Electric Power, Gas, Food, etc.

Emergency support benefit will be provided to low-income households. It is to take into consideration that rise of price of electric power, gas, food, etc. will greatly affect household budget of low income households.

Eligibility

Tax-exempted Households (for FY2023)

*Households registered with Onojo City as of Dec. 1st, 2023 and all members in the same household are exempted from residential tax (per capita levy) for FY2023.

*If you received the benefit for tax-exempted households for FY2023 (70,000 yen) at other municipalities, you are not eligible for this benefit.

- Benefit Amount 70,000 yen per household
- *Payment is done only once.

●How to Apply

We will send a notification to households who received 30,000 yen benefit for Emergency Support Benefit for Rise of Price of Electric Power, Gas, Food, etc. before and fulfill the conditions this time from January sequentially. This notification is to confirm your bank account information that you have designated. If you do not change the bank account for the transfer of the benefit, you do not have to do any procedures. We will transfer the benefit amount to the designated bank account from the end of January sequentially.

If you are eligible from this benefit, we will send a notification and an application form from the end of January sequentially. In this case, please send the application form to receive the benefit by the deadline.

When you reached 20 years old, -National Pension-

Everyone whose address is registered in Japan and aged 20 to 59 should enroll in the National Pension Scheme and pay the insurance premiums. However, if you have difficulty paying premiums because of financial reasons, you may be able to defer your premium payments through the following systems. Please contact us for further details.

Special Payment System for Student

If you are a student and have difficulty paying premiums because of economic reasons, you may be able to defer your premiums payments through the Special Payment System for Student.

Premium Payment Deferment System

If you are aged 20 to 49 and the income* of you or your spouse is under a certain amount of money, you may be able to defer your premium payment.

*In the case of the application by June, the income for 2 years ago

*In the case of the application after June, the income in the previous year

Premium Payment Exemption for the Period before and after Childbirth

- **Eligibility** Women who gave birth to a baby on February 1st, 2019 or after *Application will be accepted from 4 months of pregnancy or after. (including stillbirth)
- **●Exemption Period** 4 months from a month of scheduled due date or a month of delivery (e.g. In case of delivery in December, from November to February)
- *In case of a multiple birth event, for 6 months from 2 months before a month of delivery (e.g. In case of delivery in December, from October to March)


