## Certificate Issuance Service at Convenience Store Starts from April 2024

We start Certificate Issuance Service at convenience stores from April 2024. It becomes possible to obtain certificates at convenience stores using My Number Card (Individual Number Card) (without filling in a paper application form) from April 2024.

from Mon, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024

### Necessary Items to Obtain the Certificates

◇My Number Card ◇4-digit pin code

### ●Issuance Fee

250 yen

\*This fee is also applied to obtaining certificates by operating a terminal machine installed at Onojo City Hall and each community center using My Number Card.

\*When you obtain the certificates at Onojo City Hall and each community center using Citizen Card (Shimin Card), the fee is 300 yen the same as before.

## Certificate Issuance Service at Convenience Store Starts from April 2024

### ●Safety of Procedure

You can obtain the certificates with safety as you can obtain the certificates operating a multi-copy machine installed at a convenience store etc. by yourself without being seen by anybody.

### ●My Number Card can be used for...

- ◇Verifying identity
- ◇Health Insurance Card (can be used only at medical institutions installing a My Number Card reader.)
- ◇Filing a final tax return through e-Tax (online).
- ◇One-stop special application of Hometown Tax Donation, Furusto Nozei
- ◇Obtaining the certificates such as residence certificate, certificate of seal registration and taxation certificate, etc. through **City Online Application**.

### ●Increasing Use of My Number Card

A My Number Card is a plastic card which contains an IC chip, and the bearer's name, address, My Number (the Individual Number), and ID photograph, etc., are displayed on it. This card can be used to verify identify on line safely and surely, therefore, it will be a necessary item in a digital society.

\*You can check, register and change your registration status such as registration of My Number Card for the use of health insurance card and bank account information to receive allowances and further information such as the usage of My Number Card and services available through digital certificate for smartphone on **Mynaportal** website.

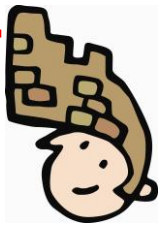

## Please do not use National Health Insurance (NHI) Card after you lose qualification

You can not use National Health Insurance (NHI) Card issued by Onojo City in the following cases.

◇When you Enroll in your employer's health insurance plan

NHI Card is not valid on and after the certified date written on your employer's health insurance card.

◇When you move out of Onojo City

NHI Card is not valid on and after the qualification acquisition date written on your NHI Card issued by the municipal office where you move in.

\*If you use NHI Card issued by Onojo City without a qualification, you must pay back the medical expense that was borne by the insurance.

\*If you need to visit a hospital before you get a new health insurance card from your company or municipal office where you move in, please consult medical institutions.

## General Service Center available on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays

General Service Center is open from 9:30am to 12:30pm on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays. You can take the following procedures on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor at Onojo City Hall.

- ◆ Acceptance of Notification of Moving-in, Moving-out, Change of Residence Inside the City or Change of Household
- ◆ Seal Registration: new registration, change of registered seal, notification of loss of registered seal, cancellation of registered seal
- ◆ Procedures of My Number Card (Individual Card) such as Reception of My Number Card (Individual Card), Change of PIN
- ◆ Applications for Child Allowance and enrollment in a nursery school
- ◆ Procedure of Enrollment in NHI (national health insurance), withdrawal from NHI and Change of NHI
- ◆ Medical Care for Children and Persons with Severe Disability

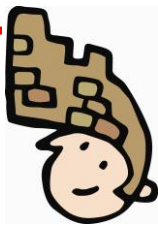

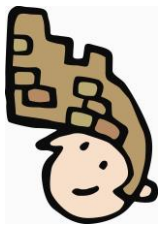

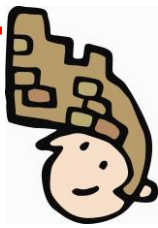
