Prepare for Earthquake

Noto Peninsula Earthquake which seismic center was Noto region, Ishikawa Prefecture, occurred on January 1st, 2024. Supports are being held by self-defense force and administrative organizations, etc. Onojo City dispatched 2 staff members of Crisis Management Section to the Disaster Response Task Force of Noto Town, Ishikawa Prefecture from Jan. 6th to Jan. 10th.)

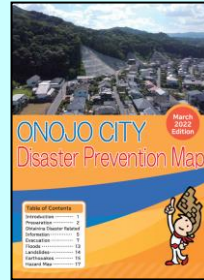
There is the Kego Fault which runs through Onojo City. It is an active fault that crosses the Sea of Genkai to Hakata Bay, and runs northwest to southeast through the Fukuoka plain. It is said the probability of a big earthquake occurrence in the southeast area of the fault. If it occurs, it is expected that we will have serious damage in Onojo City.

We never know when an earthquake will occur, therefore, it is crucial to prepare for them with proper knowledge.

We introduce what to keep in mind and tips for evacuation when an earthquake strikes. Please check your evacuation sites and its routes as well on the map.

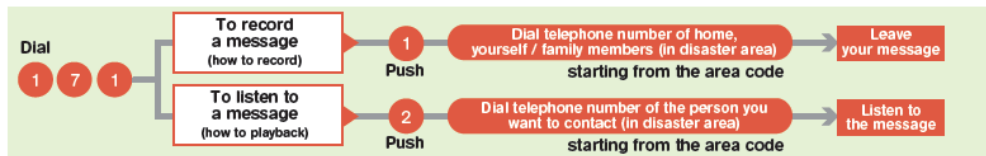

What to do when phone calls are not connected

●NTT Disaster Emergency Message Dial 171

Messages can be recorded and played back when phone calls cannot be easily connected during disasters. *This service is provided when it is difficult to get through on the phone during disasters due to an increasing number of calls for checking the safety of those in the affected area.



●Disaster message board

This service can be used when the Internet is available during disasters.

*The services are provided when major disasters have occurred. Check the details from the service providers such as NTT and mobile phone company.

Subsidy for Rubella Vaccination Expense

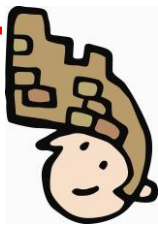

●Benefit for low-income households which are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) only (100,000 yen)

●Benefit for low-income child-rearing households (50,000 yen)

Benefit will be provided to low-income households which are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) only and low-income child-rearing households. It is to take into consideration that rise of price of electric power, Gas, food, etc. will greatly affect household budget of low income households.

●Benefit for low-income households which are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) only (100,000 yen)

●Eligibility

Households registered with Onojo City as of Dec. 1st, 2023 and all members in the same household are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) for FY2023 only or households which consist of family members who are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) for FY2023 only and exempted from residential tax.

*except households which consist of family members who are dependent of the persons who are imposed residential tax.

*If you received the benefit for low-income households which are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) for FY2023 only (100,000 yen) at other municipalities, you are not eligible for this benefit.

●Benefit Amount 100,000 yen per household

*Payment is done only once.

●Benefit for low-income child-rearing households (50,000 yen)

●Eligibility

Households registered with Onojo City as of Dec. 1st, 2023 and all members in the same household are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) for FY2023 only or exempted from residential tax and rear child(ren) age 18 or under (born on Apr. 2nd, 2005 or after).

●Benefit Amount 50,000 yen per child

*Payment is done only once.

●Benefit for low-income households which are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) only (100,000 yen)

●Benefit for low-income child-rearing households (50,000 yen)

●Procedure

If you are eligible for this benefit, we will send a notification letter or an application form from the beginning of March sequentially.

◇Households which will receive a notification letter

We will send a notification letter to households who received 70,000 yen benefit for Emergency Support Benefit for Rise of Price of Electric Power, Gas, Food, etc. and rear child(ren) age 18 or under.

◇Households which will receive an application form

We will send an application form to households which would be eligible for the benefit for low-income households which are imposed residential tax (per capita levy) for FY2023 only (100,000 yen) *including household rearing child(ren) age 18 or under.

●Payment of the Benefit from the end of March sequentially

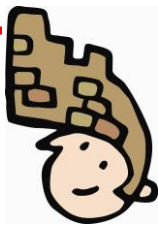

Discarding Procedure for Motor Cycle or Light Motor Vehicle (Kei car)

If you have a registered motor cycle or light motor vehicle and fall under any of the followings, please carry out a procedure for discarding your vehicle by Mon, Apr. 1st. Otherwise, this year's Light Vehicle Tax will be imposed to the registered owner (as of April 1st).

- ◆ Vehicle is non-usable (broken)
- ◆ You do not have the vehicle any more (stolen, handover, etc.)
- ◆ Your address is registered out of Onojo City (move-in or move-out)
- ◆ The owner is dead (If someone else is still using the vehicle, please take a procedure for changing the name of the owner.)

*Unlike Motor Vehicle Tax, there is no taxation system on monthly basis for Light Vehicle Tax



Have you paid the 10th period of National Health Insurance Tax?

The deadline of payment of the 10th period of National Health Insurance Tax is Mon, Apr. 1st. Delinquent charge will be charged the payment is overdue. Please make sure to pay by the deadline.

- **Delinquent Charge** 8.7% annually for 2024
- *From the next day of the deadline to the day a month passes: 2.4% annually
- *Making a payment of municipal tax etc. by direct debit is convenient. For application, please contact us.

Please take necessary procedures when moving in and out

Please take necessary procedures within 14 days from the date of living in a new place when you move in from outside the city and change residence inside Onojo City. When you move out from the city, the application will be acceptable from 2 weeks prior to the scheduled moving-out date.

You can also take procedures such as national health insurance, other medical cares at the same time.

*If the management company of your apartment, housing or house is managing your water and sewerage rates, please contact them.

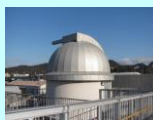

Immunity of new born babies decreases as they grow. Therefore it is necessary to boost their immune system by themselves and vaccination helps it. In preparation for entrance to school in April, please take a vaccine and prevent infectious diseases.

● Remarks

- ◆ Though regular vaccinations are free of charge, in case of receiving them after the subject ages, you are required to pay for them.
- ◆ Please have your child vaccinated when he/she is in good physical condition.
- ◆ Confirm firmly your child's vaccination history to avoid duplication of the vaccination.

● How to Take

- ◆ Please make an appointment at a medical institution beforehand.

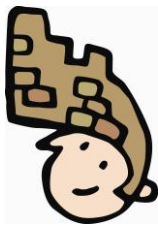

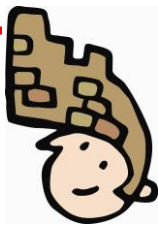
