#### Do you know about "Child Allowance"?

You are entitled to receive Child Allowance if you are nursing a child.

●Subject Child Child up to junior high school grade

\*until the following March after 15<sup>th</sup> birthday (You might not be eligible if the child is enrolled in a child welfare facility. In this case, please contact us.)

- **Eligibility** Who is nursing a subject child/children
- Monthly Amount of Child Allowance
  - ◆0 2 years old 15,000yen
  - ♦3 years old Elementary School grade

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> child: 10,000yen, 3<sup>rd</sup> child and after: 15,000yen

- ◆Junior High School grade 10,000yen
- \*If the income is between the income limitation A (or more) and (under) the income limitation B, flat rate of 5,000yen per child will be provided.
- \*If the income is the income limitation B or more on the chart below, Child Allowance will not be provided.

### Do you know Act for Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances?

The law provides for a collection and recycling system in which home appliance retailers take charge of collecting used home appliances and home appliance manufacturers take charge of recycling collected appliances. Those who use home appliances shall pay for recycling costs.

#### <Home appliances regulated>

Air conditioners, Television sets, Refrigerators, Washing machines

- How to Ask Retailers
  - ◆When purchasing a new appliance
    - ⇒Ask the retailer at which you will purchase a new one
  - ◆When disposing of an old appliance
    - ⇒Consult with the shop where you purchased it or the shop near your home
- Collection Costs Vary by kind and retailer
- Recycling Costs 990yen (Vary by kind and manufacturer)

#### **Health Check-up for Older Senior Citizens**

Health check-up can detect problems early on and it prevents diseases and worsening of diseases. We sent the health check-up coupon to subject persons at the end of April.

\*Persons who will turn 75 in May 2024 or later will receive the health check-up coupon on around 10<sup>th</sup> of birth month.

#### Subject Person

Those who are a member of Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (後期高齢者医療)

\*Except subject persons who are admitted into the hospital for a long time or are staying at a welfare facility.

  - ♦ Individual health check-up: after receiving Health Check-up Coupon - Mon, Mar. 31<sup>st</sup>
- ●Place ♦ Group health check-up: Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza, each community center, Mikasanomori Elementary School
  - ♦ Individual health check-up: designated medical institutions \*Reservation required.




#### Historic Site Tour - Onojo Walk -
