[(Sound of Alert) "This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. We are going to broadcast Earthquake Early Warning for a drill"] \Rightarrow [(Sound of Alert) "Earthquake Early Warning.", "This is a huge earthquake", "This is a broadcast just for a drill."] \Rightarrow (Repeated three times) \Rightarrow ["This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. This is the end of the broadcast for the drill." (Sound of Alert)]

What is "Earthquake Early Warning (Kinkyu Jishin Sokuho)"?

Onojo City uses the system of "J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert)" to inform Earthquake Early warning (EEW). When occurrence of an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 4 and upper or long-period ground motion level 3 and upper is forecast in Fukuoka Area, EEW which is transmitted from the government will be broadcasted by the disaster information communication system which is installed in 61 places inside Onojo City.

A fire drill for Onojo City staff members will be held about 1 hour during the period from Wed, Nov. 1st to Tue, Nov. 7th. Regular services will be offered during this drill. Your participation would be highly appreciated if you happen to visit Onojo City Office during the time.
