### COVID-19 Vaccination for Children between 6 months old and 11 years old

We will send the COVID-19 vaccination ticket to persons who have used all of the vaccination tickets we sent before. If you have a vaccination ticket we sent before, please use it. Please discuss with your child about taking the vaccine and make a right decision for you all with the right knowledge of efficacy and risk of side effects of the vaccine to prevent the infection.

#### Vaccination Interval

You must leave an Interval of 3 weeks or more from the 1<sup>st</sup> dose to receive 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. You must leave an Interval of 8 weeks or more from the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose to receive 3<sup>rd</sup> dose.

[Additional Dose]

You must leave an Interval of 8 weeks or more from the previous dose.

### **♦ Children between 5 years old and 11 years old**

[Primary Series]

You must leave an Interval of 3 weeks or more from the 1<sup>st</sup> dose to receive 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

[Additional Dose]

You must leave an Interval of 3 months or more from the previous dose.

- Vaccination Period Sun, Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 Thu, Feb. 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 (except the closed days of medical institutions)
- Vaccination time once
- ●Co-payment Amount 1,500yen

#### [Co-payment-exempt]

If you have Co-payment Maximum Amount Certificate for Long-Term Care Insurance for the Elderly(介護保険負担限度額認定証),Co-payment Maximum Amount and Standard Co-payment Reduction Certificate for Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (後期高齢者医療限度額適用・標準負担額減額認定証) or Co-Payment Exemption Notice for Influenza Vaccination (インフルエンザ予防接種自己負担金免除通知書),the vaccination fee will be exempted.

- \*You can receive influenza vaccine without any interval from COVID-19 vaccination.
- \*Advanced appointment necessary. There is a case that you cannot take influenza vaccine for a reason of the supply of influenza vaccine.
- \*It takes about 2 weeks to develop immunity to influenza virus. Please receive the vaccine before the spread of influenza in winter.
- \*Please consult with your family doctor beforehand whether you can receive the vaccination in case that you are under medical treatment, you have allergies(such as for eggs), or you have Physical Disabilities Handbook.
- \*Influenza vaccination fee is set by each medical institution for persons other than the subject persons.
