Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

●Mass Vaccination

●Vaccination Venue

- ◇Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza 【4-2-1 Kawarada, Onojo City】
- ◇Minami Community Center 【5-9-1 Minamigaoka, Onojo City】

We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to subject residents for the 3rd dose whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

*The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we decided to provide the booster shot from February 2022.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1st and 2nd doses. Please see the page No. 2.

●Booster Shot Available Dates

Example1

Available from the same date after 6 months from the date of the 2nd dose.

Example2

When there is no same date after 6 months from the 2nd dose, it is possible to take the 3rd vaccine from the 1st of the next month.

(In the case that the 2nd dose was on Oct. 31st, 2021, the 3rd dose is available from May 1st, 2022)

- ◆Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.
- ◆You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online.
- ◆If you need any help such as language support at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.
- *If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know by one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.
- *You cannot make or change a reservation at a vaccination venue.

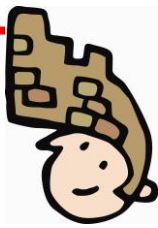

School Expense Subsidy

-School supplies and school lunch fees will be subsidized-

Part of the school supply expense will be subsidized for families having financial difficulties. Please note that you need to apply for the School Expense Subsidy every year.

●Subject person

Elementary school student or Junior High School student in Onojo City whose family falls under any of the following;

- ◆A family receiving Child Rearing Allowance
- ◆A family who falls under any of the following as to residential tax
 - A family whose total residential tax (per income levy) in 2021 is under the base amount
 - Residential Taxes of all family members in 2022 are non-taxable
- ◆A family who went through suspension or abolition of public assistance within a year.

●Application Acceptance

From Fri, Apr. 8th at Education Policy Section, Onojo City Hall, 5F (Weekday, 8:30am-5:00pm) or at each community center (9:00am-9:00pm except for 3rd Tuesday)

*If you apply by Thu, June 30th, you can receive the aid retroactive to April 2022.

*Though you can submit the application form at each community center (Japanese-speaking staff only), please visit Education Policy Section if you have any inquiries.

●Necessary Items

- ◆Application form (You can download from the HP of Onojo City or receive at Education Policy Section)
- ◆Passbook of transfer account with the name of child's guardian as the account holder
- ◆Necessary documents which proves that you are a qualified recipient

*You will receive a detailed notice through schools in April.

National Pension Payment Notice to be sent

2022's National Pension Payment Notice will be sent to you from Japan Pension Service (Nihon Nenkin Kiko). 2022's monthly payment is 16,590 yen. *You can make a payment at a post office, a financial institution or a designated convenience store nearby.

<If you leave your office>

You and your spouse (if you have) need to take a necessary procedure to enroll in the National Pension Scheme.

Necessary Items ◇My Number Card (Individual Number Card) or Pension Booklet ◇Certificate of Ineligibility of Employer's Health Insurance or Certificate of Unemployment

<Student Special Payment System>

Available for students. When you are a student and your income is under certain amount, you may be able to defer your premium payments. Please visit Onojo City Hall with the following items if you would like to apply. *Please note that you need to apply for Student Special Payment System every year.

Necessary Items ◇Student ID Card or Certificate of Enrollment ◇My Number Card (Individual Number Card), Pension Booklet or Payment slips

Please take necessary procedures when you enroll in or withdraw from National Health Insurance (NHI) within 14 days

Enrolling (When withdrawing from your employer's health insurance plan and enrolling in NHI)



●**Necessary Items:** Document to identify yourself such as My Number Card (Individual Number Card) and a valid driver's license card, Certificate of Ineligibility of Employer's Health Insurance

Withdrawing (When withdrawing from NHI and enrolling in your employer's health insurance plan)

●**Necessary Items:** Health Insurance Card of your employer's health insurance plan (all cards of your family), NHI Card (all cards of your family)

"Traffic Safety Campaign" from Apr. 6th to 15th

●Drunk Driving Elimination

If you consume any kind of alcohol, do not operate any automobile, bicycle or motorbike. Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law, and severely punished. Additionally, providing alcohol to someone you are with will be driving or being a passenger in a vehicle that you know the driver has consumed alcohol is also punishable by law. If you are drinking, don't drive, if you're driving, don't drink.

●Traffic Accident Prevention

When you drive, please pay careful attention to pedestrians, especially children and elderly people, and make an effort to prevent traffic accident.

Drivers and pedestrians need to pay careful attention to traffic.



●Promotion of Safe and Proper Bicycle Use

When you ride on a bicycle, please follow safety rules to prevent an accident. If you have an accident, there will be a case that you are required to pay compensation to a victim. To protect you and a victim, it is mandatory for cyclists to buy bicycle insurance from Oct. 2020.

Procedure for Starting Water Supply

As you need to submit the commencement of water and sewage use notification when starting your water supply, please make sure to contact us if you have difficulty taking the procedure in Japanese.

Dog Registration and Vaccination against Rabies

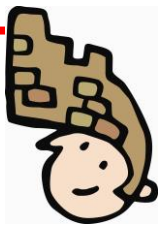
Dogs aged 91 days and older must be registered with Onojo City and vaccinated against rabies once a year. It is mandated by the Rabies Prevention Act.

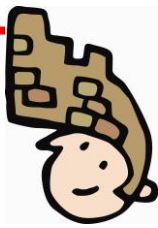
