Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination Schedule in August

COVID-19 Vaccination will be given at night during weekdays from August. Vaccination venues will be Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza and Minami Community Center from Tue, Aug. 17th.

● **Reservation Schedule** *Age is as of March 31st, 2022.

| Persons aged 12*-29 | We have not decided the date of starting reservation yet. We will inform you of the schedule once it is decided. |

*For a while, vaccination ticket will be send next month of birth month to persons who turn 12 years old during the period from August 2021 to the end of February 2022.

● How to make a vaccination reservation

◆ Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.

◆ You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online. Phone lines will be so busy right after accepting the reservation. Therefore please use online reservation as much as possible.

◆ If you need any help such as language support at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.

*If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.

*You cannot make a reservation at a vaccination venue.

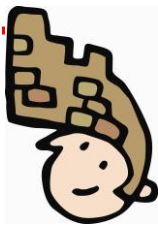

◆Due to the delay of vaccine supply, the vaccination might be cancelled. We will inform you of the cancellation 4 days before the day that vaccination will be conducted on the HP of Onojo City and the vaccination reservation website.

We will send a post card to persons who cannot take a vaccine due to the cancellation.

◆When we cancel the vaccination due to a natural disaster, we will inform you of the information on the HP of Onojo City and the vaccination reservation website as needed.

Registration on a list of residents who need assistance in a disaster

Onojo City makes a list of residents who need assistance in a disaster. This is for the people who have difficulties to evacuate on their own when a disaster occurs. Foreign residents in Onojo City can also apply for registration. We share information with institutions such as Kasuga Police Station, autonomous disaster prevention organization in each administrative area, etc. If you wish to register, please contact us.

Watch out for Red Back Spiders and Hornets!

Venomous spiders named Red Back Spider were found in Onojo City and other areas. They are not aggressive. However you will get bitten if you touch them. Their bite is poisonous to people and possible symptoms in case of the bite are localized pain, sweating, having a fever, swelling and redness at the bite site. If you get bitten, please rinse the bite site with water gently and visit a hospital. When you find the spider, please do not touch it. Also, please report when you find them.



Hornets named Vespa Velutina is found the dwelling in Tsushima City, Nagasaki and found in every area in Kyusyu. Its body length is about 2cm. It builds a nest high location in a tree or a building. The nest is on higher and larger than the nest of native hornet. It is said that the symptom of its sting is almost the same as native one. When you find its nest, please contact us. When you expel it, please ask an exterminator.

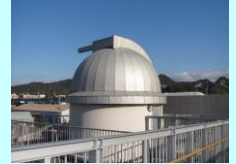

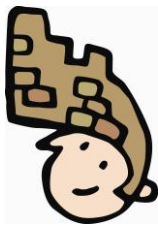

COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate (Vaccine Passport)

COVID-19 vaccination certificate (vaccine passport) is issued to ease COVID-19 quarantine when people enter other countries.

●Subject Person

Those who fall under all of the followings

- ◇You are registered in Onojo City and fully vaccinated.
- ◇You have a valid passport and have a plan to go abroad.

*Please refrain from applying for the COVID-19 vaccination certificate as much as possible if you do not have any plan to go abroad.

●Certification Details

COVID-19 vaccination record (type of vaccine, date received, etc.) and individual information (name, date of birth, passport number, etc.)

●Necessary Documents for Application

◇Application form

*You can download from the HP of Onojo City.

◇Copy of a valid passport that passport number and name in alphabet are clearly shown.

*If you have a plan to renew your passport, please bring the new passport.

◇Document to prove COVID-19 vaccination history

◇Copy of Certificate of Vaccination for COVID-19 (For General Public)

◇Document to identify yourself such as residence card, valid driver's licenser

◇Return envelope with a stamp

*Please write your address and name on the front.

Eliminate Drunk Driving Week - Aug. 25th to Aug. 31st -

Drunk Driving is a serious crime. If you consume any kind of alcohol, do not operate any automobile, bicycle or motorbike. Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law, and severely punished. Additionally, providing alcohol to someone that you know the person will drive a vehicle or being a passenger of a vehicle in the situation that you know the driver has consumed alcohol is also punishable by law. If you are drinking, don't drive, if you're driving, don't drink.

Please do not dispose of syringes in a household garbage bag

When you dispose of syringes you used at home, please bring them to a medical institution or ask the collection to a contractor. When you dispose of household garbage, please keep in mind the following points.

How to dispose of household garbage in the time of novel coronavirus infection

- ◇Tie up the top of household garbage bag firmly
- ◇Let the air out of household garbage bag
- ◇Drain food garbage well ◇Keep in mind to reduce the amount of garbage
- ◇Sort garbage correctly

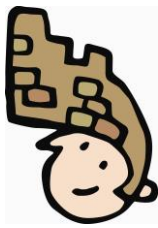
