

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Booster Shot (3rd Dose)

It is reported that effectiveness of COVID-19 vaccine and the ability to prevent infection with COVID-19 may decrease over time even after taking COVID-19 vaccine twice. Therefore, it is considered to be necessary to offer additional doses (the 3rd doses) of COVID-19 and we are conducting the vaccination for the 3rd doses from December.

●Subject Person

Persons aged 18 or over who took 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine

*The vaccine will be given after 8 months or more from the date of the 2nd dose.

*Please make sure your 2nd vaccination date on Certificate of Vaccination for COVID-19 (予防接種済証), etc.

●Vaccination Period

2 nd dose	Period for 3 rd dose (the same day after 8 months or more)
April 2021	on or after December 2021
May 2021	on or after January 2022
June 2021	on or after February 2022
July 2021	on or after March 2022
August 2021	on or after April 2022
September 2021	on or after May 2022
October 2021	on or after June 2022
November 2021	on or after July 2022
December 2021	on or after August 2022

●Distribution Period of Vaccination Ticket

We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to eligible persons to take the 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine in order.

*In the case that the time of taking the 2nd dose of COVID-19 vaccine is different, the period of receiving the vaccination ticket for the 3rd dose is different even among your family members.

●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd COVID-19 dose.

●Possible Dates for Vaccination Reservation

Example1

Following the government guideline, it is basically possible to take the vaccine on or after the same date in or after 8 months from the date of the 2nd dose.

Example2

When there is no vaccination date on or after 8 months from your 2nd dose, it is possible to take the 3rd vaccine on or after 1st of the next month.

●Possible Vaccination Dates (Example)

Example1 In the case of the 2nd dose was on June 14th, 2021

The 3rd dose is available on or after Feb. 14th, 2022

Example2 In the case of the 2nd dose was on June 30th, 2021

The 3rd vaccination is possible on or after Mar. 1st, 2022

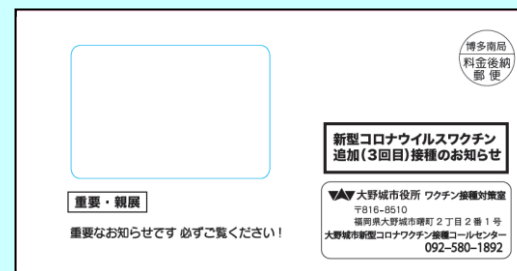

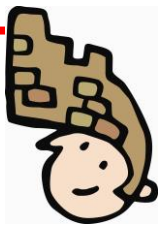


【Envelope for the 3rd vaccination from Onojo City Office】

We will inform you of the cancellation 4 days before the day that vaccination is scheduled to be conducted on the HP of Onojo City and the vaccination reservation website. We will send a post card to persons who cannot take a vaccine due to the cancellation. ◆When we cancel the vaccination due to a natural disaster, we will inform you of the information on the HP of Onojo City and the vaccination reservation website as needed.

Renewal of City Water Meter

City's water meter should be replaced with a new one every 8 years. A contractor will visit you to replace the water meter which expiry date is approaching. We will send notification letters to houses which fall under the replacement until a week before it. While replacing, you cannot use tap-water for about 15 minutes. Please turn off all faucets until replacing work is finished.

●Drunk Driving Elimination

If you consume any kind of alcohol, do not operate any automobile, bicycle or motorbike. Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law, and severely punished. Additionally, providing alcohol to someone you are with will be driving or being a passenger in a vehicle that you know the driver has consumed alcohol is also punishable by law. If you are drinking, don't drive, if you're driving, don't drink.

●Traffic Accident Prevention

When you drive, please pay careful attention to pedestrians, especially children and elderly people, and make an effort to prevent traffic accident. Drivers and pedestrians need to pay careful attention to traffic.

●Promotion of safe and Proper Bicycle Use

When you ride on a bicycle, please follow safety rules to prevent an accident. If you have an accident, there will be a case that you are required to pay compensation to a victim. To protect you and a victim, it is mandatory for cyclists to buy bicycle insurance from Oct. 2020.

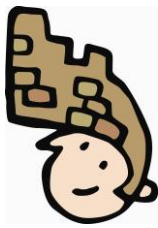

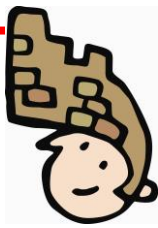

School Expense Subsidy for New 1st Grade Student of Elementary or Junior High School (Advanced Application)

-School supplies and school lunch fees will be subsidized-

Part of the school supply expense will be subsidized for families having financial difficulties. Please note that you need to apply for the School Expense Subsidy every year.

●Subject person

Elementary school student or Junior High School student in Onojo City who will be new 1st grade student in April 2022 and whose family falls under any of the followings;

- ◆ A family receiving Child Rearing Allowance
- ◆ A family whose total residential tax (per income levy) in 2021 is under the base amount
- ◆ A family who went through suspension or abolition of public assistance within a year

●Application Period and Acceptance

From Fri, Jan. 7th to Mon, Feb. 28th at Education Policy Section, Onojo City Hall, 5F (Weekday, 8:30am-5:00pm) or at each community center (9:00am-9:00pm except for 3rd Tuesday)

*If you apply during application period and are qualified for the aid, you can receive fee for school supplies on 25th next month of application. Other subsidy will be supplied after July.

City has provided 2 projects for After-school Day Care, "Gakudo Hoiku" and "Randoseru-Club", for the place that elementary school students can spend their time after school.

These projects aim to develop independence and sociality of children through various activities.

These 2 will be fully integrated in April 2022 and day care and various activities will be provided at all elementary schools in Onojo City under the name of "Randoseru-Club".

The "Randoseru- Club" has 2 registration types, G-registration and R-registration.



G-registration

- Available 5 weekdays on school days.
- After hours care is available.
- Available during school holidays (spring, summer and winter holidays, compensatory days off, Saturdays).
- Have requirements.

R-registration

- Choose 3 days from school days.
 - After hours care is not available.
 - Not available during school holidays (spring, summer and winter holidays, compensatory days off, Saturdays).
- You might use 2 types together for spring, summer and winter holidays or Saturdays if you fulfill the conditions we require. For further information, please contact us.

●No requirements

Anyone who is elementary school 1st - 6th grade students can apply.

*Days you can choose differ from school to school.

*The number of students we can accept is limited.

*This time, we only accept applications for G-registration (previous Gakudo Hoiku). Application for R-registration (previous Randoseru-Club) starts from April.

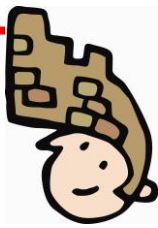

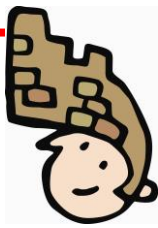

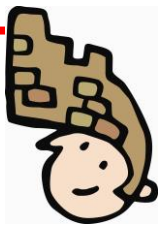
