

## Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

We use Pfizer vaccine and Moderna vaccine for COVID-19 booster shot (3<sup>rd</sup> dose). We used Pfizer vaccine for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccinations held by the city, but we decided to use Pfizer vaccine and Moderna vaccine for the booster shot (3<sup>rd</sup> dose) and set vaccination dates for Pfizer vaccine and Moderna vaccine for the reason that the amount of the supply of Pfizer vaccine for the booster shot to the city is smaller than that of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccinations.

At the time of the pharmaceutical approval of the government of Japan, between Pfizer Inc. and Moderna, Inc., safety and efficacy of taking a different vaccine (Pfizer vaccine or Moderna vaccine) for the booster shot is confirmed when taking different vaccine from the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccinations.

If you wish to take the booster shot as soon as possible, please make a reservation soon regardless of the type of the vaccine.

The vaccine we use at the vaccination venues varies depending on the vaccination day.

Vaccine you can take depends on the vaccination day. Please confirm the type of the vaccine on your vaccination day when making a reservation.

\*We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to eligible persons to take the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of COVID-19 vaccine in order.

## Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

### ●Distribution Schedule of Vaccination Ticket (Subject to change)

The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3<sup>rd</sup> dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we decided to provide the booster shot from February 2022. We will send a vaccination ticket to subject residents aged 65 or over whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and subject residents aged 64 or younger whose vaccination interval is 7 months from the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

### ●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3<sup>rd</sup> COVID-19 dose. \*Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> doses. Please see the page No. 2.

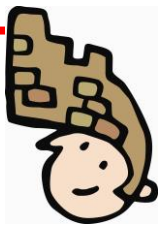

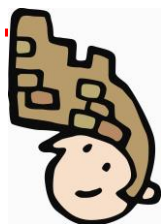

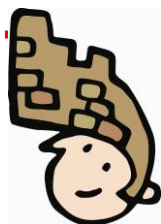
