Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

COVID-19 is spreading.

We use Pfizer vaccine and Moderna vaccine for COVID-19 booster shot (3rd dose). We used Pfizer vaccine for the 1st and 2nd vaccinations held by the city, but we decided to use Pfizer vaccine and Moderna vaccine for the booster shot (3rd dose) and set vaccination dates for Pfizer vaccine and Moderna vaccine for the reason that the amount of the supply of Pfizer vaccine for the booster shot to the city is smaller than that of 1st and 2nd vaccinations.

At the time of the pharmaceutical approval of the government of Japan, between Pfizer Inc. and Moderna, Inc., safety and efficacy of taking a different vaccine (Pfizer vaccine or Moderna vaccine) for the booster shot is confirmed when taking different vaccine from the 1st and 2nd vaccinations.

If you wish to take the booster shot as soon as possible, please make a reservation soon regardless of the type of the vaccine.

The vaccine we use at the vaccination venues varies depending on the vaccination day.

Vaccine you can take depends on the vaccination day. Please confirm the type of the vaccine on your vaccination day when making a reservation.

●Subject person for the booster shot

Persons aged 18 or over who took 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine

*We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to eligible persons to take the 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine in order.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

●Distribution Schedule of Vaccination Ticket (Subject to change)

The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we decided to provide the booster shot from February 2022. We will send a vaccination ticket to subject residents aged 65 or over whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose and subject residents aged 64 or younger whose vaccination interval is 7 months from the 2nd dose.

●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd COVID-19 dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1st and 2nd doses. Please see the page No. 2.

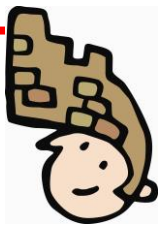

- ◆Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.
- ◆You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online.
- ◆If you need any help such as language support at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.
- *If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know by one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.
- *You cannot make or change a reservation at a vaccination venue.

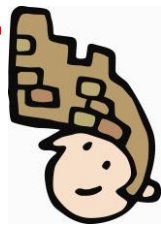
