Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to subject residents (aged 12 or older) for the 3rd dose whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

*The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we are providing the booster shot from February 2022.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

■Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1st and 2nd doses. Please see the page No. 2.

When there is no same date after 6 months from the 2nd dose, it is possible to take the 3rd vaccine from the 1st of the next month.



Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination for 4th Dose

Based on the policy of the government of Japan, we will provide the 4th dose of COVID-19 vaccine to subject persons.

Subject Person

Persons who received the 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine 5 or more months ago and fall under any of the following below.

- ①Persons aged 60 or older (Application is not necessary.)
- ②persons aged 18 59 with underlying diseases or diagnosed with a risk of severe illness from COVID-19. (Application is necessary.)
- *Persons who have Health Welfare Handbook for persons with mental disabilities or Handbook for persons with intellectual disabilities are considered to be persons with underlying disease even in the case that they are not visiting a hospital or not hospitalized.
- *For the application, please contact us.
- *Please ask your family doctor about what conditions are considered to be underlying diseases in this case.



Prevent Heat Stroke!

Severe heat stroke can possibly lead to death. Please take preventive measures as follows:

- (a) Drink liquid even when you don't feel thirsty. Get salt when you sweat a
- (b) Pay attention to the temperature. Use fans or an air conditioner indoors. Wear sweat-absorbent material clothing.
- (c) Maintain your health. Take adequate diet and sleep.
- (d) Consider others and speak to each other at home and office, etc.
- (e) About half of heat stroke patients are seniors. Pay attention to the temperature even in a room and drink liquid often.



- (g) Be careful of wearing a mask in the situation of high temperature and humidity.
- (h) When you are wearing a mask, avoid heavy work or exercise. After you keep adequate distance from others, take off a mask and have a rest.

Have you paid Municipal and Prefectural Tax and National Health Insurance Tax?

Notice of National Health Insurance Tax Payment

Notice of National Health Insurance Tax Payment for 2022 (April 2022 - March 2023) will be sent in the middle of June. To the person who made a payment by deduction from your pension in 2021, it will be sent in the middle of July. Even if the householder is not a member of National Health Insurance, this notice will be sent to the householder when the household has at least one family member who is a member of this insurance. In that case, the tax of the householder is not included. *The person aged 75 and above who is a member of Older Senior Citizens' Medical System is required to pay the premium of the system. The payment notice of the premium will be sent in the middle of July.

Earthquake Early Warning for Drilling

Earthquake Early Warning for Drilling announced by The Fire and Disaster Management Agency and The Japan Meteorological Agency will be broadcast in Japanese.

Date

Wed, June 15th Around 10:00am

*Will be cancelled depending on the weather conditions and seismic activity.

<English Translation>

[(Sound of Alert) "This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. We are going to broadcast Earthquake Early Warning for a drill"] \Rightarrow [(Sound of Alert) "Earthquake Early Warning.", "This is a huge earthquake", "This is a broadcast just for a drill."] \Rightarrow (Repeated three times) \Rightarrow ["This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. This is the end of the broadcast for the drill." (Sound of Alert)]

What is "Earthquake Early Warning (Kinkyu Jishin Sokuho)"?

Onojo City uses the system of "J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert)" to inform Earthquake Early warning (EEW). When occurrence of an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 4 and upper is forecast in Fukuoka Area, EEW which is transmitted from the government will be broadcasted by the disaster information communication system which is installed in 60 places inside Onojo City.
