●Subject person for the booster shot (3rd dose)

Persons aged 18 or over who took 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine

*We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to eligible persons to take the 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine in order.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we decided to provide the booster shot from February 2022. We will send a vaccination ticket to subject residents aged 18 or over whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd COVID-19 dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1st and 2nd doses. Please see the page No. 2.

- ◆Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.
- ◆You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online.
- ◆If you need any help such as language support at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.
- *If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know by one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.
- *You cannot make or change a reservation at a vaccination venue.

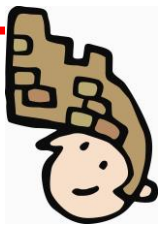

You can not use National Health Insurance (NHI) Card issued by Onojo City in the following cases.

◇When you Enroll in your employer's health insurance plan

NHI Card is not valid on and after the certified date written on your employer's health insurance card.

◇When you move out of Onojo City

NHI Card is not valid on and after the qualification acquisition date written on your NHI Card issued by the municipal office where you move in.

*If you use NHI Card issued by Onojo City without a qualification, you must pay back the medical expense that was borne by the insurance.

*If you need to visit a hospital before you get a new health insurance card from your company or municipal office where you move in, please consult medical institutions.

Recommendation to make a payment such as payment of a municipal tax through an account transfer

What's an Account Transfer? It is one of the methods to make a payment such as payment of a municipal tax. If you go through the procedure at the financial institutions which offer the service, fees are transferred to recipients automatically from the account you designated by each payment period.

Merits of Account Transfer

Convenient when making a payment

- ◆ You don't have to take the trouble to visit a municipal office or a financial institution for making a payment during busy weekdays.
- ◆ Once you go through the procedure, the service is continued automatically next year and later.

Safe and Secure

- ◆ You don't have to go out with cash.
- ◆ You can avoid forgetting to make a payment carelessly since the fee is certainly transferred within a payment period.



How to Apply

Please apply at a financial institution with ◇Pass Book◇Your Personal Seal which you used for opening your account◇Payment Notification◇Request Form for Account Transfer (You can apply at a section in charge of each fee.)

*A Request Form for Account Transfer is attached to a payment notification. Or you can obtain it at financial institutions in Onojo City and Onojo City Office.

Citizen Service Section available on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays

Citizen Service Section is open from 9:30am to 12:30pm on 2nd and 4th Saturdays. You can take the following procedures on the 1st floor at Onojo City Hall.

Main Services

- ◆ Issuance of certificates such as residence certificate, certificate of personal seal registration, tax certificate
- ◆ Acceptance of Birth, Marriage, Death notification (Not issuance of residence certificate with new family members or without the departed)
- ◆ Acceptance of Notification of Moving-in, Moving-out, Change of Residence Inside the City or Change of Household
- ◆ Seal Registration: new registration, change of registered seal, notification of loss of registered seal, cancellation of registered seal
- ◆ Procedures of My Number Card (Individual Card) such as Application and Reception of My Number Card (Individual Card), Change of PIN
- ◆ Applications for Child Allowance and enrollment in a nursery school
- ◆ Procedure of Enrollment in NHI (national health insurance), withdrawal from NHI and Change of NHI
- ◆ Medical Care for Children and Persons with Severe Disability
- ◆ Payment of municipal tax
