

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

Children aged 5 - 11 will be eligible for taking a COVID-19 vaccine from March. We will send a COVID-19 vaccination ticket and notification to subject persons in March.

●To Guardians

Please discuss with your child about taking the vaccine and make a right decision for you all. Please make a decision under the will of guardians/parents with the right knowledge of efficacy and risk of side effects of the vaccine to prevent the infection.

●Subject Person Children aged 5 - 11

We recommend children with especially severe underlying diseases to take the vaccine. Please consult with your family doctor before taking the vaccine.

●COVID-19 vaccine type for children aged 5 - 11

Pfizer vaccine for children

*The components are one third of that for persons aged 12 and older.

●Necessary Items

- ◇All documents we sent to the subject person
- ◇Document to identify the subject person such as My Number Card (Individual Number Card), health insurance card, etc.
- ◇Maternal and Child Health Handbook (as much as possible)

●Way of taking the vaccine

- ◇Mass Vaccination
- ◇Individual Vaccination

*Guardian consent is required for the vaccination to the subject persons.

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

●Subject person for the booster shot (3rd dose)

Persons aged 18 or over who took 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine

*We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to eligible persons to take the 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine in order.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we decided to provide the booster shot from February 2022. We will send a vaccination ticket to subject residents aged 18 or over whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd COVID-19 dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1st and 2nd doses. Please see the page No. 2.

Onojo Day Care Room for Sick Child

When guardians are unavailable to look after their child who is sick due to work or other commitments, temporary day care service for sick or injured children is available in a special facility at a clinic below. Advanced registration is necessary to use this service.

●**Subject Person** Child from aged 90 days to 6th grader of elementary school, who is sick or injured, but the condition is recovering and has no need to be admitted to a medical institution.

●**Name of Clinic** Matsuda Children's Clinic (1-7-18 Shimoori, Onojo City)

●**Maximum use of this service** within 7 days in a row, in principle.

●**Service Hours**

◇ Mon. - Fri. 8:30am - 5:30pm ◇ Saturdays 8:30am - 12:30pm

*Closed on Sundays, National Holidays, Bon Holidays, New Year holidays, Clinic Non-consultation days

●**Limit** 6 children / day ●**Fee** 2,000 yen / day

*There is the case that fee will be reduced or exempted depending on income of guardians.

*Please bring lunch, snack, milk, diapers, etc.

*Additional medical fees will be charged separately depending on a child's medical condition.



Infant Immunization Week from Mar. 1st to 7th

Immunity of new born babies decreases as they grow. Therefore it is necessary to boost their immune system by themselves and vaccination helps it. In preparation for entrance to school in April, please take a vaccine and prevent infectious diseases.

●**Remarks**

◆ Though regular vaccinations are free of charge, in case of receiving them after the subject ages, you are required to pay for them.

◆ Please have your child vaccinated when he/she is in good physical condition.

◆ Confirm firmly your child's vaccination history to avoid duplication of the vaccination.

●**How to Take**

◆ Please make an appointment at a medical institution beforehand.

●**Necessary Item**

Items such as Maternal and Child Health Handbook, by which vaccination history is confirmed.

Health Check-up for Older Senior Citizens

Period of the check-up is until Mar. 31st, 2022

Health Check-up can detect problems early on and it prevents diseases and worsening of diseases. The Check-up includes the checks of oral health, eating habits, etc.

●**Subject Person**

Those who are a member of Older Senior Citizens' Medical System

*Persons who are under treatment are also eligible.

●**Place** Designated medical institutions *Reservation required

*Please contact your family doctor first.

*Please check your body temperature and wear a mask when you visit a medical institution.

●**Necessary Items** ◆ Insurance Card ◆ Health Check-up Coupon ◆ Health Check-up Fee: 500 yen ◆ Medical check-up results of the previous year (If you have)

*Persons who will turn 75 in March will receive the health check-up coupon on around 10th of birth month.

●**Check-up Items**

◇ Body measurement ◇ Blood pressure ◇ Blood lipid Test ◇ Liver Function Test ◇ Blood Sugar Test ◇ Urine Test ◇ Kidney Function Test

*Other tests will be conducted when a doctor decides its necessity.

Prepare for Earthquake

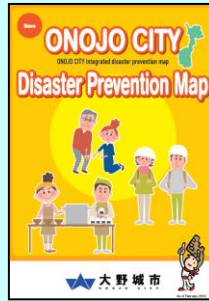
As you know, the Great East Japan Earthquake occurred on March 11th, 2011 and many precious lives were lost by it. The areas affected by it are still under recovery. Big earthquakes hit Kumamoto in 2016 and Hokkaido in 2018.

There is the Kego Fault which runs through Onojo City. It is an active fault that crosses the Sea of Genkai to Hakata Bay, and runs northwest to southeast through the Fukuoka plain. It is said the probability of a big earthquake occurrence in the southeast area of the fault. If it occurs, it is expected that we will have an earthquake with a maximum seismic intensity 6 in Onojo City. We never know when an earthquake will occur, therefore, it is crucial to prepare for them with proper knowledge.

We introduce what to keep in mind and tips for evacuation when an earthquake strikes. The information is from the Onojo City Disaster Prevention Map (booklet) renewed and issued in Apr. 2019.

What to do when...

You are on the road:

Protect your head with the bag etc. from window glasses, roof tiles or other falling objects, and evacuate to an open field or park.

Caution Do not get close to concrete block walls and vending machines. Be careful with tottering power poles and sagging power cables.

You are driving a car:

Slow down gradually, pull over to the left side, and turn off the engine. Keep calm until the quake subsides. Gather information from the car radio.

Caution When evacuating, leave the key in the keyhole and do not lock the car. Take your valuables with you and evacuate on foot.

You are in an elevator:

Push the button of every floor and get out where it stops.

Caution When you are locked up inside, do not try to break out, but keep communicating with outside through an emergency call unit and wait for rescue.

Near mountain or slope:

Be careful with falling rocks and slope collapses.

In a crowded facility:

Follow the instruction of facility staffs. Act calmly. Do not rush to the exit.

Disasters may strike when family members are not together. Hold advance family discussions to be ready for actions when an emergency occurs.

Check inside and outside your home and repair any hazardous areas in preparation for disasters.

Discarding Procedure for Motor Cycle or Light Motor Vehicle (Kei car)

If you have a registered motor cycle or light motor vehicle and fall under any of the followings, please carry out a procedure for discarding your vehicle by Thu, Apr. 1st. Otherwise, this year's Light Vehicle Tax will be imposed to the registered owner (as of April 1st).

- ◆Vehicle is non-usable (broken)
- ◆You do not have the vehicle anymore (stolen, handover, etc.)
- ◆Your address is registered out of Onojo City (move-in or move-out)
- ◆The owner is dead (If someone else is still using the vehicle, please take a procedure for changing the name of the owner.)

*Unlike Motor Vehicle Tax, there is no taxation system on monthly basis for Light Vehicle Tax



Please let us know when you are moving out

When you are moving out (within the city or outside the city), you will need to take the procedure of disconnection of water supply and settle your water and sewerage rates. Please make sure to contact us at least 5 days before your move-out.

*If the management company of your apartment, housing or house is managing your water and sewerage rates, please contact them.

Please take necessary procedures when moving in and out

Please take necessary procedures within 14 days from the date of living in a new place when you move in from outside the city and change residence inside Onojo City. When you move out from the city, the application will be acceptable from 2 weeks prior to the scheduled moving-out date.

You can also take procedures such as national health insurance, other medical cares at the same time.





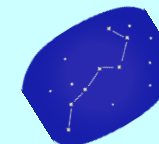

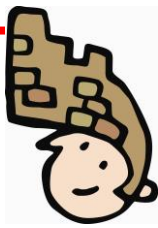
