Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

- Mass Vaccination
- Vaccination Venue
 - ♦ Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza [4-2-1 Kawarada, Onojo City]
 - ♦ Minami Community Center [5-9-1 Minamigaoka, Onojo City]
 - * Vaccination will be held only at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza from Sun. May 22nd, 2022.

We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to subject residents (aged 12 or older) for the 3rd dose whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

*The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we are providing the booster shot from February 2022.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3^{rd} dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1^{st} and 2^{nd} doses. Please see the page No. 2.

Booster Shot Available Dates

Available from the same date after 6 months from the date of the 2nd dose. Example2

When there is no same date after 6 months from the 2nd dose, it is possible to take the 3rd vaccine from the 1st of the next month.



Special Benefit for Newborn Babies

We provide Special Benefit for Newborn Babies to support guardians who raise their babies in the situation of COVID-19.

Subject Person

Newborn babies who are born during Apr. 1st, 2022 - Mar. 31st, 2023 and registered as residents on the Basic Resident Registration System in Onojo City at birth

Eligibility

Persons who are registered on the Basic Resident Registration System as mother or father at the new born babies' birth

Amount of Benefit

Cash payment of 100,000 yen per each eligible person

*Payment is limited to once per eligible person

●How to Apply

- ◇Persons who submit birth certificate to Onojo City
- ⇒Fill in an application form when submitting birth certificate
- ♦ Persons who submit birth certificate to other cities
- ⇒Onojo City will send an application form to mother's or father's address by post.

*It will take about a month from submission of birth certificate to sending the application form.

Do you know about "Children Allowance"?

You are entitled to receive Children allowance if you are nursing a child.

- ●Subject Child Child up to junior high school grade (Not eligible if the child is enrolled in a child welfare facility)
- **Eligibility** Who is nursing a subject child/children
- Monthly Amount of Child Allowance
 - ◆0 2 years old 15,000yen
 - ◆3 years old Elementary School grade 1st and 2nd child 10,000yen, 3rd child and after 15,000yen
- ◆Junior High School grade 10,000yen
- *If the income is between the income limitation A (or more) and (under) the income limitation B, flat rate of 5,000yen per child will be provided.
- *If the income is the income limitation B or more on the chart below, Children Allowance will not be provided from June 2022.

Rubella Anti-body Test and Vaccination for Adult Males

Rubella is strongly infectious disease and the main symptom is a fever and rash. The route of the infection is through cough, droplet and sneezing of infected people. Coupon of Rubella anti-body test and vaccination was sent to subject persons, but it expired. Therefore, the Coupon will be sent again by the end of May to subject persons who do not take the test and vaccination yet.

Subject Person

♦ Males who were born from Apr. 2nd, 1962 through Apr. 1st, 1979 *The coupon had been sent from FY2019 to FY2020.

Procedure

1) With the coupon and documents to identify yourself, you can take Rubella anti-body test at specific medical checkup held by the city, health checkup held by your company or designated medical institutions.

2In case that you are diagnosed with low antibody levels in Rubella anti-body test, you take Rubella vaccination at designated medical institutions.
