Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

 - * Vaccination will be held only at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza from Sun. May 22nd, 2022.

We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to subject residents (aged 12 or older) for the 3rd dose whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

*The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we are providing the booster shot from February 2022.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3^{rd} dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1^{st} and 2^{nd} doses. Please see the page No. 2.

Booster Shot Available Dates

Available from the same date after 6 months from the date of the 2nd dose. Example2

When there is no same date after 6 months from the 2nd dose, it is possible to take the 3rd vaccine from the 1st of the next month.



Health Check-up for Older Senior Citizens

Health Check-up can detect problems early on and it prevents diseases and worsening of diseases. The Check-up includes the checks of oral health, eating habits, etc. We send the health check-up coupon to subject persons at the end of April.

*Persons who will turn 75 in May 2022 or later will receive the health check-up coupon on around 10th of birth month.

Subject Person

Those who are a member of Older Senior Citizens' Medical System (後期高齢者医療)

Automobile tax and light vehicle tax are decided based on the categories such as type, usage and engine displacement and imposed on car owners as of April 1st and the notification of payment will be sent in the beginning of May.

Do you know Act for Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances?

The law provides for a collection and recycling system in which home appliance retailers take charge of collecting used home appliances and home appliance manufacturers take charge of recycling collected appliances. Those who use home appliances shall pay for recycling costs.

<Home appliances regulated>

Air conditioners, Television sets, Refrigerators, Washing machines

- How to Ask Retailers
 - ♦When purchasing a new appliance
 - ⇒Ask the retailer at which you will purchase a new one
 - ◆When disposing of an old appliance
 - ⇒Consult with the shop where you purchased it or the shop near your home
- ●Collection Costs Vary by kind and retailer
- Recycling Costs 990yen (Vary by kind and manufacturer)
