Vaccination for 1st dose of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) is held only at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza from November

Vaccination at Minami Community Center finished for 1st dose of COVID-19 in October, considering the progress of the vaccination conducted by the city Vaccination for 1st dose of COVID-19 is held only at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza from November. 2nd dose of COVID-19 vaccine will be held until Thu, November 18th.

To Guardians

Persons aged 12 and older are eligible for taking the vaccine. Please discuss with your child about taking the vaccine and make the right decision for you all.

♦ Guardian consent is basically required for the vaccination to persons aged under 16.

♦ When your child is absent from school for the reasons such as taking vaccination, side effect of the vaccine such as a fever, school will specially give a holiday to the child.

♦ For a while, vaccination ticket will be send next month of birth month to persons who turn 12 years old during the period from September 2021 to the end of February 2022.

• Practice preventive measures even after taking the vaccine

Even after taking the vaccine, please keep practicing preventive measures such as wash and disinfect your hands frequently and thoroughly, wear a mask, avoid the "Three Cs" (Closed spaces, Crowded places, Close-contact settings).

*If you take the vaccine at a venue other than the city vaccination venue after making a vaccination reservation in Onojo City, please be sure to cancel your vaccination reservation in Onojo City.

Acceptance of Application for Nursery School Enrollment for the new academic year to begin

If you are planning to use a nursery school, a small-sized nursing establishment or an authorized "Kodomo-En" (nursery section) for the new academic year (from Apr.1st, 2022 - Mar.31st, 2023), please submit an enrollment application to Childrearing Support Section of Onojo City. Even if you once applied for the academic year 2021 and your child is now being taken care at a nursery school, a small-sized nursing establishment or an authorized "Kodomo-En", you are required to take the same procedure again.

*"Small-sized nursing establishment" will accept infants aged 0-2 as of Apr.1st, 2022 and Authorized "Kodomo-En" (nursery section) will accept infants aged 0-5 as of Apr.1st, 2022. The application period and method will be same as the ones of authorized nursery schools. "Small-sized nursing establishment" is a nursing facility which is authorized by Onojo City and takes care of up to 19 infants. Authorized "Kodomo-En" is a combined facility of a nursery school and a kindergarten which is authorized by Fukuoka Prefecture.

Please submit the documents 2 months prior to the start of your child care. Application is closed on the last day of every month. In case that the city office is closed on the last day of the month, please apply by the day before the last day.

e.g. Start in May \Rightarrow Submission by the end of March.

♦ In the case of enrollment in March 2022, the deadline is Tue, Dec. 28th, 2021.

How to Apply

Please visit Childrearing Support Section and submit the application form and necessary documents.

Remarks

- ◆Not all the applications will be admitted in the case of exceeding the quota of each nursery school, small-sized nursing establishment or authorized "Kodomo-En". Also, the admission of an infant is decided in accordance with the degree of necessity of child care, not on first-come, first-served basis.
- ◆Make sure to fill out the application form for academic year 2022.
- ◆Before submitting your application, please make sure to visit at least one of the nursery schools you have chosen together with your child. (Visiting the first choice nursery school is preferred.) Otherwise, your application may not be accepted.
 - *You make an appointment at each nursery school by yourself.
- ◆In the case of failure to submit necessary documents such as a certificate of employment, a certificate of childrearing leave or submission of incomplete documents, your application will not be accepted.
- ◆ As Narashi Hoiku (Temporary short time day care for getting accustomed to a new environment) is included in the regular day care period, please apply by the deadline of the month in which Narashi Hoiku will be done.

What is "Earthquake Early Warning (Kinkyu Jishin Sokuho)"?

Onojo City uses the system of "J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert)" to inform Earthquake Early warning (EEW). When occurrence of an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 4 and upper is forecast in Fukuoka Area, EEW which is transmitted from the government will be broadcasted by the disaster information communication system which is installed in 50 places inside Onojo City.




