Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

●Mass Vaccination

●Vaccination Venue

- ◇Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza 【4-2-1 Kawarada, Onojo City】
- ◇Minami Community Center 【5-9-1 Minamigaoka, Onojo City】

* Vaccination will be held only at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza from Sun. May 22nd, 2022.

We confirm the vaccination history on the Vaccination Record System (VRS) and send a vaccination ticket that is combined with questionnaire to subject residents (aged 12 or older) for the 3rd dose whose vaccination interval is 6 months from the 2nd dose.

*The interval of COVID-19 vaccination for booster shot (3rd dose) is shortened by the policy of the government of Japan. In response to this, we are providing the booster shot from February 2022.

*Vaccination schedule is sent with the vaccination ticket. We might add the mass vaccination dates. For the latest information, please check the HP of Onojo City or contact us.

●Reservation Period

You can make a reservation as soon as you received the vaccination ticket for the 3rd dose. *Vaccination reservation procedure is the same as the 1st and 2nd doses. Please see the page No. 2.

●Booster Shot Available Dates

Example1

Available from the same date after 6 months from the date of the 2nd dose.

Example2

When there is no same date after 6 months from the 2nd dose, it is possible to take the 3rd vaccine from the 1st of the next month.

(In the case that the 2nd dose was on Oct. 31st, 2021, the 3rd dose is available from May 1st, 2022)

*The 1st dose and the 2nd dose are also available at mass vaccination venue. For the dates of the 1st dose and the 2nd dose, please contact us.

*If you wish to take COVID-19 vaccine as soon as possible, please make a reservation. Taking COVID-19 vaccine reduces a risk of severe illness, prevents long-term effects and protects the lives of people who cannot take the vaccine.

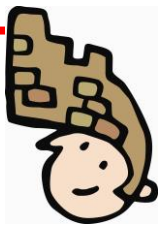

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination for 4th Dose

Based on the policy of the government of Japan, we will provide the 4th dose of COVID-19 vaccine to subject persons.

●Subject Person

Persons who received the 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine 5 or more months ago and fall under any of the following below.

①Persons aged 60 or older (Application is not necessary.)

②persons aged 18 - 59 with underlying diseases or diagnosed with a risk of severe illness from COVID-19. (Application is necessary.)

*Persons who have Health Welfare Handbook for persons with mental disabilities or Handbook for persons with intellectual disabilities are considered to be persons with underlying disease even in the case that they are not visiting a hospital or not hospitalized.

*For the application, please contact us.

*Please ask your family doctor about what conditions are considered to be underlying diseases in this case.

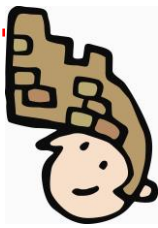

Preparation for Localized Heavy Rain



Natural disasters such as floods and landslide disasters occur frequently by localized heavy rain in recent years because of the influence of global climate change. They are unexpected and the scale of them is sometimes beyond our imagination. However, it will be possible for us to mitigate the damage caused by disasters by taking preventive measures. We never know when disaster will occur, so it is crucial to prepare for it with proper basic knowledge to act calmly in case of a disaster.

●Gather information early

Please check weather information in your area

●Evacuate early

It is important to evacuate before heavy rain. Check weather information to know the latest weather.

Check Onojo City Disaster Prevention Map (booklet) and make sure evacuation sites in your area and actions you take during a disaster. Please take actions to protect your precious life without hesitation in a situation of evacuation.

Tips for Evacuation

○People who need time for evacuation such as the elderly and people with disabilities evacuate from danger when Alert Level 3 is issued.

We create a list of people who need assistance in evacuating during a disaster. If you want to register you on this list, please contact us.

○All must evacuate by Alert Level 4.

When Alert Level 5 is issued, the situation is Life-threatening, your life is already in danger. Please evacuate from danger when Alert Level 4 is issued.

Onojo City prepares Onojo City Disaster Prevention Map using the latest information on infection prevention measures, evacuation and emergency action plans for your residential area. Please see the upper right column about how to obtain Onojo City Disaster Prevention Map.

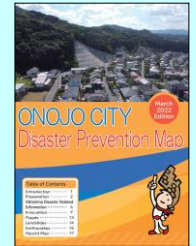

Elevated railway of Nishitetsu Tenjin Omuta Line starts operation at the end of August

A project elevating a part of railway of Nishitetsu Tenjin Omuta Line is in progress. Present railway will be closed and a new elevated railway will start operation at the end of August 2022. The railway will be elevated between Zasshonokuma Station area and Shimoori Station area. Therefore, railway crossings will be closed in 19 points in the area between Zasshonokuma Station area and Shimoori Station area (5.2km) at the end of August. The railway crossings will be removed sequentially.

- ◇Railway crossings will be closed in 19 points at the end of August.
- ◇Entrance of Nishitetsu Shimoori Station will be changed.
- ◇Temporary Shimoori Station will be dismantled.
